



## 2020 MEMBERSHIP PACKET FAQ

Since the release of our 2020 Membership categories and rates, we have had numerous questions regarding the various membership levels, especially House Memberships. These FAQs are intended to address these questions and alleviate any confusion that may have been generated. Of course, please let us know if you have any questions that are not addressed here.

- *When does the membership year run?*  
The current membership year ends March 31, 2020. The 2020 membership year runs from April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021.
- *Will you have to be a member to dine or have a drink at Linwood Country Club in the new membership year?*  
No. With the new liquor license, which we anticipate will be in place by April 1, 2020, the food and beverage outlets at the Club will be open to the public and membership will not be required to dine or enjoy a cocktail.
- *Are the food and beverage outlets currently open to the public?*  
No. Until April 1, 2020, membership is currently required to utilize the bar or dining room at the Club.
- *If you don't have to be a member to dine or drink, what is the benefit of the "House" membership?*  
The House and House Plus Memberships take the place of what were formerly referred to as "social" and "social plus" memberships. The benefits offered by these memberships include:
  - Ability to make dining reservations 30 days in advance (versus the general public which can only make reservations 7 days in advance).
  - Access to "Members Only" social events.
  - Discounted pricing on ticketed social events that are open to the public.
  - Access to the card room.
  - For "House Plus" members, ability to golf once per month at prevailing daily rates; charging privileges; access to golf events on a space available basis.

- If I am currently a social member, am I eligible to renew at last year's rates?*  
 Yes. If you are currently a social member you can renew as a House Member for \$100 if you renew before April 20, 2020. If you are currently a social plus member, you can renew as a House Plus Member for \$300 if you renew by April 20, 2020.
- If I am a returning member, do I have to fill out the form again?*  
 Yes. We need your current contact and credit card information to process your membership, as well as your signature on the membership agreement for this year.
- How do I indicate which membership level I am signing up for?*  
 On the chart of membership options, check or circle the membership you are applying for.
- How do I indicate that I want my dues spread out over 7 months?*  
 We have changed the form to include a box to check if you choose this option. If you have the application sent out previously, you can write it in above your credit card information.
- Is the golf course going to be open to the public?*  
 No. The golf and tennis facilities will remain private and membership is required to use those facilities.
- Are the card rooms going to be open to the public?*  
 No. You will need a House Membership at a minimum to use the card rooms.
- Do you have to be a member to host a social function at the Club?*  
 No. As of April 1, 2020 you will not be required to join the club in order to host a social or business function at the club.
